We want our children to understand the importance of being a good citizen in preparation for their future life and education

#### Parents and carers will:

- o Ensure pupils arrive on time, every day and ready to learn. This includes a good sleep routine, breakfast, reading book, correct school uniform including PE kit.
- Strive to meet the attendance target of 96% but ensure attendance does not fall below 90%.
- o Provide a safe, secure and happy environment at home where learning (reading to and with, times tables and spelling) can take place.
- Let the school know immediately of any concerns/ worries and changes at home which may affect their child's learning or behaviour.
- o Support the school by following the relationships & behaviour policy.
- Attend parents meetings (at least twice a year, three times for pupils with SEND), read and acknowledge any written reports sent home.
- o Read all letters and information sent home to ensure they hold all relevant and up to date information.
- o Provide feedback to the school e.g. by completing surveys
- o Give permission for my child(ren) to have access to devices, the internet and to ICT systems.
- Know that my child(ren) will receive, online safety education to help them understand the importance of safe use of technology and the internet – both in and out of school.

### Pupils will:

- Follow the expectations for behaviour (SAFE, READY, RESPECTFUL).
- Use regulation resources and adult support to co-regulate
- Take home all letters and information when asked.
- Read and take AR quizzes regularly and bring in reading book every day.
- Wear the correct school uniform. Including PE kit provided by their parents/ carers.
- Talk to an adult if they are worried about anything.
- Come to school rested and ready to learn.
- Try to drink 2 bottles of water during the school day.

## This is how we stay safe when we use devices:

- I will ask a teacher or suitable adult if I want to use the computers/tablets
- I will only use activities that a teacher or suitable adult has told or allowed me to use
- I will take care of computers/tablets and other equipment
- I will ask for help from a teacher or suitable adult if I am not sure what to do or if I think I have done something wrong
- I will tell a teacher or suitable adult if I see something that upsets me on the screen
- I know that if I break the rules I might not be allowed to use a computer/tablet

### St. George's will:

- Follow the agreed relationships & behaviour policy
- Provide a safe, happy and focused learning environment which allows teachers to teach and pupils to learn.
- Ensure an effective, exciting and relevant curriculum is delivered every day.
- Give support to all pupils and families.
- Provide reading books, paper copies or devices to enable pupils and parents to complete the expected home learning.
- Send out relevant information regularly.
- Be available to address concerns or receive information about pupils.
- Review and act on feedback provided where required.
- Ensure that pupils will have good access to digital technologies to enhance their learning
