St Georges PTFA uses Facebook for our social media communication. This can be viewed here: [St Georges PTFA Facebook](#)

The St Georges PTFA Facebook presence is an open page. This means it can be accessed by any Facebook user without permission being given by St Georges PTFA.

St Georges PTFA uses its Facebook group exclusively for the running of the association. It is used to communicate with members of the community, promote events, to recruit volunteers to support the PTFA's activities, thank local supporters and canvass members of the community's views.

Usage that is not permitted

The Facebook group of St Georges PTFA does not allow any personal correspondence between members, is not intended for discussing any aspect of the school and/or nursery, other than the PTFA and its activities and should not be used to promote any business other than where this is done for the benefit of the PTFA and with its permission.

Inappropriate posts, including any derogatory comment, can and will be removed by the administrator and the PTFA retains the right to ban any user who continues to make inappropriate use of the group.

Members and volunteers of St Georges PTFA should not post on behalf of the PTFA, on their personal accounts. However, sharing official PTFA posts through their own accounts is permitted.

Photographs

The Facebook group of St Georges PTFA allows Facebook administrators to post photographs. However, it is explicitly assumed that anyone posting a photograph will own the rights to the image and will have the permission of anyone featured to do so. St Georges PTFA accepts no responsibility regarding ownership or permissions for any photographs posted by members of the group.

Permission must be granted from individual children's parents/carers before being featured within the Facebook account. No names of children will be included.
