At St Georges we know that children and adults flourish when, through love and nurture, they are engaged in learning that is challenging, adventurous and meaningful. We recognise all children want to learn and behave well. Therefore, we seek first to understand their behaviours and support them.

Adult Behaviour

The adults at St Georges will:

- Set clear, consistent and fair expectations.
- Always recognise good behaviour first.
- Always act with care and understanding.

3 Expectations

The learners at St Georges will be:

- Ready
- Respectful
- Safe

Class Rewards

Positive reinforcement in class:

- Praise
- House points
- Dojo points

Above and Beyond Rewards

Recognition for excellence:

- Headteacher's Awards
- ELLI Certificates
- Conversation or message home.

Levels of consequence

Promoting good behaviour in class within one session of learning:

1. Reminder
2. Warning
3. Reflection time (inside or outside the classroom).

Should there be a repetition child will be supported by SLT in their second reflection time.

Senior Leaders

How teachers and pupils will be supported:

- Positive discussions
- Repeated reflection time to be taken with an SLT member.
- Log on CPOMS and call home where necessary.

Some behaviours will result in immediate SLT intervention
