Throughout 2025, we have focused our fundraising efforts on supporting the renovation of the outdoor space. Thanks to the incredible generosity of our community and the strong partnership with the school, we are delighted to share some exciting progress!

Alongside the school, we have successfully raised enough funds to install a trim trail – a fantastic addition designed to encourage active play, balance, and coordination. The trim trail will be located along the edge of the school field, making it easily accessible for all children to enjoy during playtimes and PE lessons.

The renovation project is a long-term initiative designed to transform the school's outdoor space into a more engaging, safe, and inclusive environment for all children. The goal is to create areas that encourage active play, creativity, and social interaction, whilst also supporting physical development and wellbeing.

Key Features of the Project

- **Trim Trail Installation:** The first major milestone of the project – a series of connected play equipment pieces that help children develop balance, coordination, and strength.
- **Improved Play Zones:** Plans include resurfacing worn areas, adding new markings for games, and creating zones for both quiet play and energetic activities.
- **Inclusive Equipment:** The project aims to introduce equipment suitable for children of all abilities, ensuring everyone can join in the fun.
- **Green Enhancements:** Adding natural features such as planting areas, shaded seating, and eco-friendly play elements to encourage outdoor learning and environmental awareness.

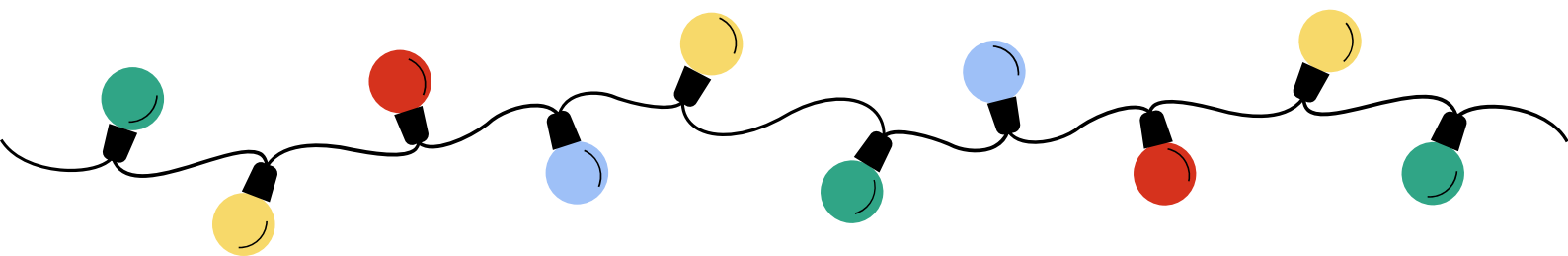
Why It Matters

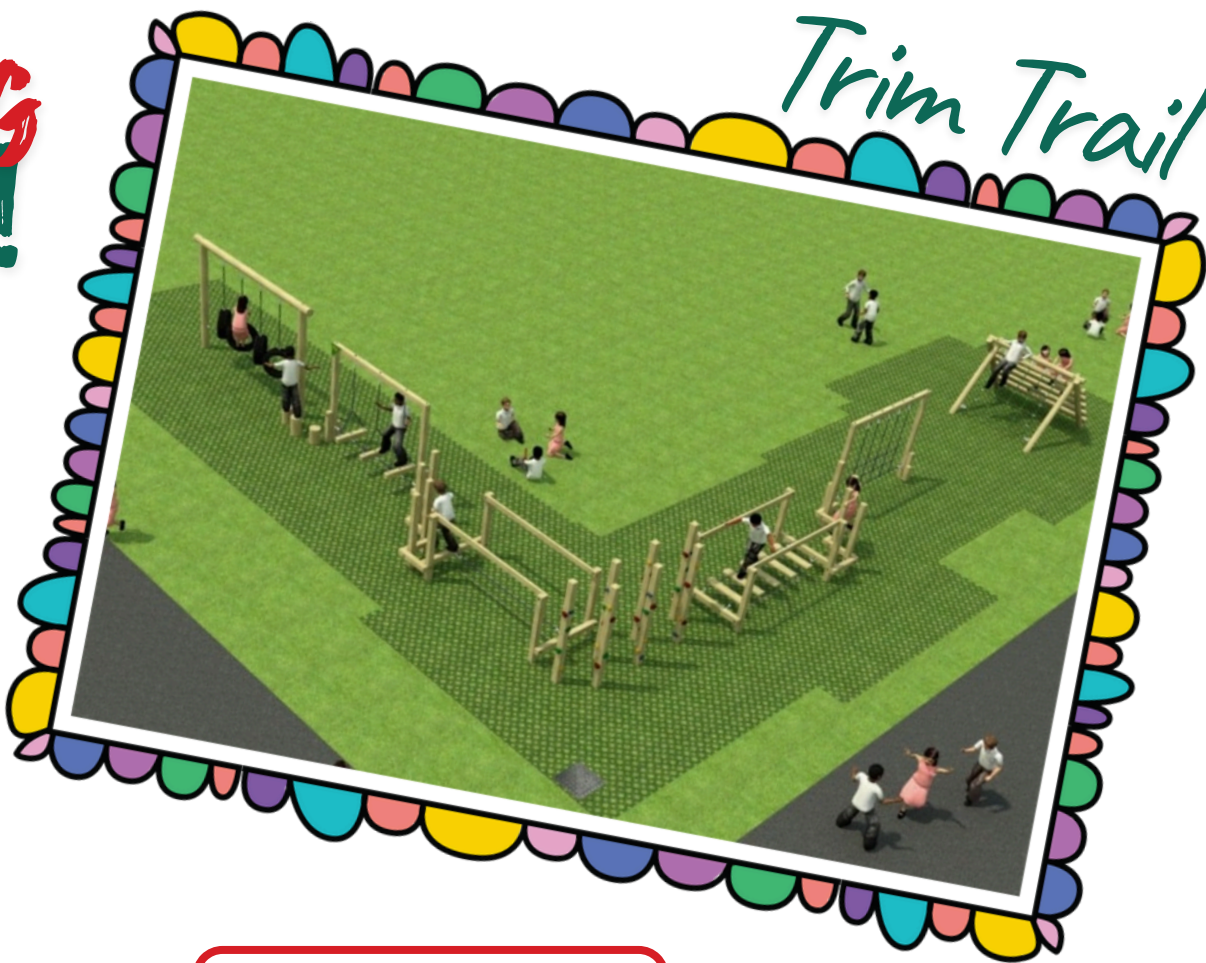
